

Welcome back!

New 2010 benefits include: All members now have a vote, all adults are eligible to serve on the Board of the Directors, and all members are listed in the Guild directory! Now, all members with email automatically receive Guild news via email nearly 30+ times/yr. (If you do not have email, our newsletter is mailed 6x/yr.) Email is the best way to receive Guild news, followed by our website, www.pacrafts.org.

Introducing Two Categories: *One will fit you perfectly!*

Craftsman—designed for the individual actively working in craft at any level—creating and/or sharing their work with the public at shows, events, exhibitions, galleries, online, or someone who wishes to be known as a craftsman, craftswoman, artist, artisan. Craftsman is intended for those who wish to apply as a craftsman at the Local Chapter, Pennsylvania Guild or national levels. Members in this category may apply for juried status from Chapter or Guild and each receives a full craft listing in the directory. Active Seniors (65+) and Students (ages 18-25) receive a 25% discount.

Friend—designed for the lover of craft but someone who is not actively working in craft, such as a spouse, Youth 17 & under, a “retired from craft” individual, the craftsman’s assistant, a senior who is no longer active, collector, friend, supporter, or patron who wishes to be connected with the Pennsylvania Guild but not participate as a craftsman. A special category here is Emeritus, a ‘retired from craft’ senior. Emeritus members retain their juried status (per bylaws), are listed fully and also receive the craftsman’s directory! But as ‘retirees from craft’ they are no longer eligible for participation benefits (such as shows, exhibitions, etc.) designed for the active craftsman. All Friends receive a 50% discount off the craftsman rate. Youth are the only Friends eligible for certain events which they enter as ‘youth emerging.’ All Friends now have a vote!

Your Renewal:

Step 1: On the renewal form, select Craftsman or Friend. If you are an organization, please use the **NEW** member form.

Step 2: Decide if you wish to be an At Large member or also participate with a Local Chapter.
